It happens that one of his younger brothers was suffering from a serious disease in both of his eyes. The doctor said that he needed surgery as soon as possible and that it would be very expensive. His father had no job, so Avadesh left his study in 9th standard and started to work as a laborer to earn money for the operation. One day, with the grace of Aghoreshwar, he came to work on our hospital building. When he saw the eye clinic he told us his problem. Dr Ivor checked his brother's eyes and said that if he did not have an operation within few weeks his brother would be blind forever. Under the care of Vision Varanasi and with the help of our friends Dr. R.K.Ojha and Dr Prashant Chaudhari (Eyesurgeon) he had the operation in a large hospital. Now his brother can see and will be able to start his studies again very soon. This inspires Avadesh to work for the Ashram. He will stay in the Ashram like other children, and he will restart his education from 9th grade.

- The Ashram is returning to normal after the floods of last September:
 - o The flooding badly damaged the gardens, but now greenery is coming back.
 - We have also started repainting the ground floor murals.
