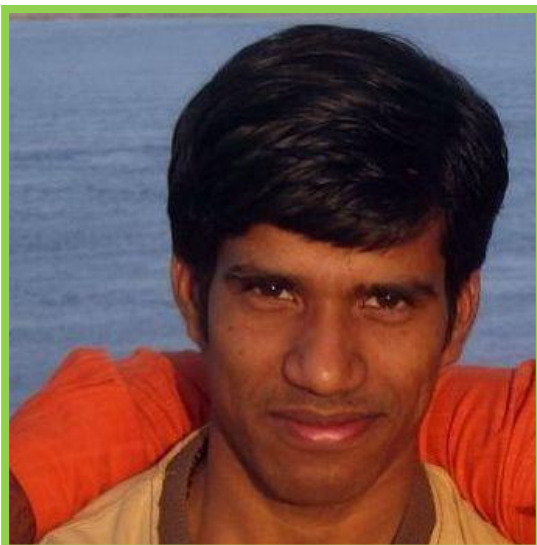
GRADUATES IN SERVICE OF THE ASHRAM

NEXT GENERATION

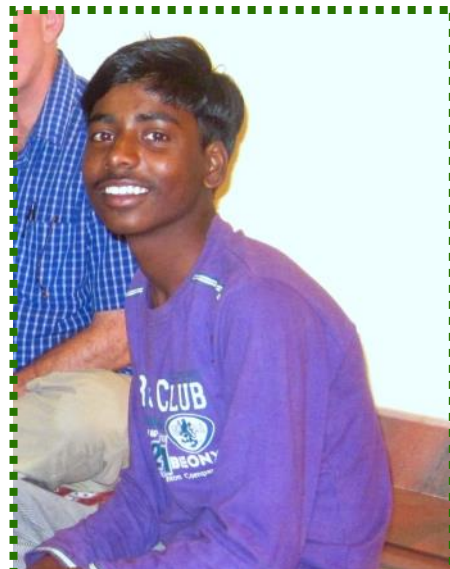


SHIVA, now 18, arrived to Bal Ashram at the age of 5.
