The population of the migrant camp has dwindled as families returned to their villages. We have identified other families in need who are sheltered in the vicinity, but have little or no means of sustenance.




The Bal Ashram sanga is dedicated. There is so much effort and cooperation through neighbors and local authorities to effectively reach families that you are helping to support.
